VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated section(s) of the Public Utilities Code (PUC) and Commission General Orders (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred during the period July 1, 2012 through November 9, 2012.

- (1) Operated as a charter-party carrier without a valid authority, in violation of PUC section 5371. [4 counts];
- (2) Operated as a charter-party carrier without evidence of public liability and property damage (PLPD) insurance coverage in effect and on file with the Commission, in violation of PUC section 5391, 5381 G.O. 115-F. [4 counts];
- (3) Engaged four (4) employee-drivers without evidence of workers' compensation insurance in effect and on file with the Commission, in violation of PUC section 5378.1. [4 counts];
- (4) Failed to enroll four (4) drivers in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) provide access to records and vehicles, in violation of PUC section 5374(a)(1)(D) and 5381 and G.O. 157-D, part 5.02 and California Vehicle Code section 1808.1. [4 counts];
- (5) Failed to pre-employment test and enroll at least four (4) drivers in the Controlled Substance and Alcohol Testing Certification Program, in violation of PUC sections 5374(a)(1)(I) and 5381, and G.O. 157-D, part 10. [4 counts];

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- (6) Failed to maintain waybills, in violation of PUC section 5381 and G.O. 157-D, part 3.01. **[3 counts]**;
- (7) Failed to produce and maintain records, in violation of PUC sections 5389, 5381 and G.O. 157-D, part 6.01. **[2 counts]**; and
- (8) Advertised as a charter-party carrier without a valid authority, in violation of PUC sections 5386 and 5413.5. **[13 counts]**.

STATEMENT OF FACTS


The above violations are documented in the attached investigator's summary report, which consists of carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before DECEMBER 3, 2012.
By way of such answer you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$ 20,000 pursuant to PUC section 5378. (Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Payment Form*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed.) **or**
- (2) Contest this citation by filing an appeal. See attached document "*How To File An Appeal*".

If you fail to respond within the 20 calendar days, you will be in default of the citation and will have forfeited your right to appeal the citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and subsequently revoked, pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187.
