

CD Advisory Notice to CAB
URF Carriers' Recent Telephone Service Changes
October 2009

AT&T California

1. Effective January 2, 2010, the monthly rates for **residential** basic services will change as shown below:

Description	09/01/2009	1/2/2010	\$ change	% change
Flat Rate Service	\$13.50	\$16.45	\$2.95	22%
Lifeline Flat Rate Service	\$6.11	\$6.84	\$0.73	12%
Measured Service	\$7.28	\$8.87	\$0.59	22%
Lifeline Measured Service	\$3.27	\$3.66	\$0.39	12%

- A rate increase will also be in effect for inside wire and some **residential service features** (e.g., call forwarding will have an increase of about \$1 to \$2; call return will increase from \$6 to \$8, etc). More information to follow.
- The rates for **business usage access lines** will also increase (e.g. 800, super trunks, etc). More information to follow.

2. Effective July 15, 2009, the **residential** rate for the following service has changed:
