This Quick Reference Guide: **All Users** provides users with instructions and guidelines for all users to search the Compliance with Ordering Paragraphs (COPs) application. Use this QRG to guide you while in the COPs application.

Background

California Public Compliance with Ordering Paragraphs (COPs)

The COPs application tracks compliance with Ordering Paragraphs (OPs) of regulated entities with Commission decisions. On a monthly basis, various agency staff members will use COPs to identify, and enter relevant OPs, verify and document compliance, and produce reports summarizing compliance with OPs

Status Definitions

Each OP is assigned a status, which can be updated and notes added as compliance is tracked.

- Not Yet Due: The OP has a specified due date in the future.
- In Compliance: Compliance item has been completed and verified by the due date.
- Pending Verification by SME: A new OP has been assigned; awaiting SME to verify compliance.
- Not in Compliance: Compliance item has not been completed and is past the due date.
- Tracked in FPT: The action specified is financial and tracked in Financial Payment Tracker (FPT).
- Not Compliance Item: The OP does not include a compliance item.

Compliance with Ordering Paragraphs Application

All public users have access to search OPs and create reports. The steps below outline how to access COPs, complete a search, and filter and export data from COPs.



Step 2: Review OPs

- Click any row to access the View Ordering Paragraphs Detail page. Alternately, you can search for specific information by using the appropriate filters:
 - Select from the **Industry** drop down menu.
 - Enter a date range in the **Due Date** column to search OPs that are due in the coming month.
 - Select Status from the drop down menu to search by OP status.

Step 3: Create a Report

- Click **Export to Word** and save and open the file on your computer.
- Alternately, click OP Summary Statistics Report from the COPs home page to create a summary statistics report. Note: The OP Summary Statistics Report reflects an aggregate of all OPs listed in COPs.
